Medication for children can be a very confusing process. What is the right dosage for my child? What are the side effects of this medication? Can my child take these medications together? Do they need to have food with this medication? We have the same questions here at the centre. That is why we are not permitted to give over the counter medications, and why there must be a pharmacy label on all medications. The pharmacy label will help ensure children are getting the correct medications, at the right time, and in the correct dosage.

When bringing your medication into the centre please do not leave it in your child's cubby area. Please hand the medication to a teacher, and fill out the medication form before you leave. For quicker processing you can print a medication form from our website "Forms page"
